

Armadillo

Armadillos are medium sized mammals with a bony outer shell and a scaly tail. They live in south and east Texas.

Beaver

Beavers are large, brown aquatic rodents that inhabit many of the streams and lakes of Texas.

White-tailed Deer

White-tailed Deer are brown deer with short ears and white tails. They range across all of Texas.

Opossum

Opossums are small white creatures with dark ears and scaly tail. They are the only marsupials native to Texas.

Striped Skunk

Striped Skunks are small black mammals with two white strips.

Cotton-tailed Rabbit

These rabbits are quick, brown animals with long ears and a white tail.

Fox Squirrel

Fox Squirrels are large reddish-brown tree squirrels native to east Texas.

Feral Pig

Feral Pigs are large wild pigs usually dark brown or black in color. They travel in packs across Texas.

Coyote

Coyotes are medium sized, dog-like animals that are usually gray or brown in color. They are found throughout the state.

Raccoon

Raccoons are clever, mostly gray mammals with a distinct black face 'mask' and bushy tails.

Bobcat

Bobcats are medium sized, short-tailed cat with dark spots on its coat. It is found across Texas.

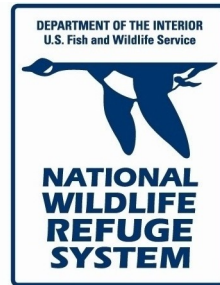
